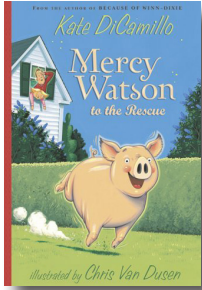

MOOSE'S BIG IDEA

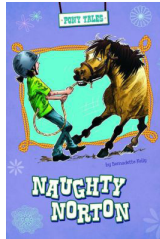
Greene, Stephanie

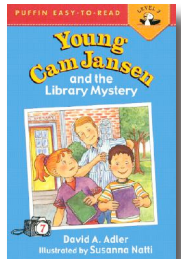

Adler, David

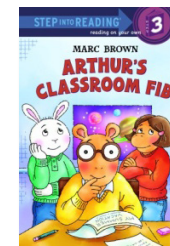
Cam has a photogenic memory, which comes in handy when her father can't find the shopping list he lost at the library.

MINNIE AND MOO AND THE HAUNTED SWEATER

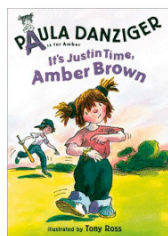
Cazet, Denys

HOUNDSLEY AND CATINA AND THE BIRTHDAY SURPRISE

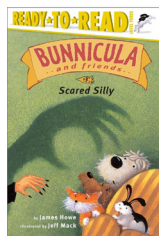
Gay, Marie-Louise

Kate and her best friend and cowhorse, Cocoa, have many adventures together, and most of them involve food for Cocoa.

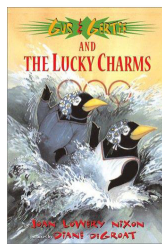
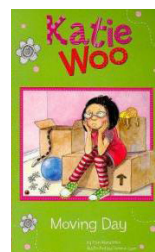
FROG AND TOAD ARE FRIENDS

GUS & GERTIE AND THE LUCKY CHARMS

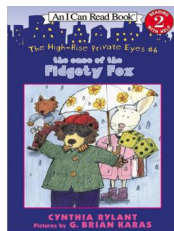
Nixon, Joan Lowry

THE HIGH-RISE PRIVATE EYES: THE CASE OF THE FIDGETY FOX

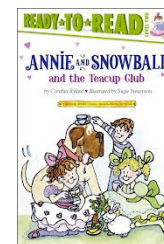
Rylant, Cynthia

Sharmat, Marjorie Weinman

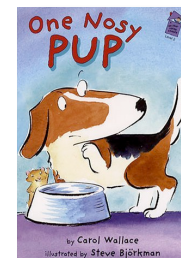
Nate and his dog Sludge are determined to find the recipe for his mother's monster cookies.
