

BIG NATE STRIKES AGAIN


Peirce, Lincoln

THE CRAZY CASE OF MISSING THUNDER


Abbott, Tony

Barrows, Annie


When 7-year-old Bean plays a mean trick on her sister, she learns that Ivy, her new neighbor, is less boring than she suspected.

THE PAINTING THAT WASN'T THERE



Brezenoff, Steve

Greenburg, Dan



ALVIN HO: ALLERGIC TO GIRLS, SCHOOL, AND OTHER SCARY THINGS


Look, Lenore
