

THE WILD ROBOT

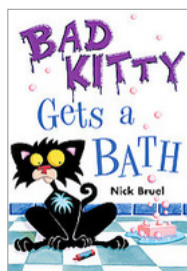
Brown, Peter

Bruel, Nick

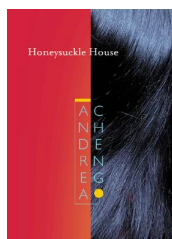
Kitty doesn't like getting a real bath with soap and water!

NOTSO HOTSO

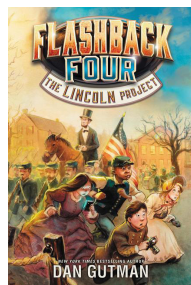
Fine, Anne

SWINDLE

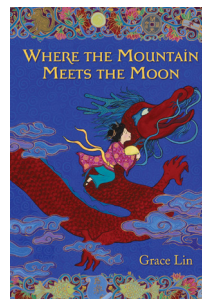
Korman, Gordon

DRITA, MY HOME GIRL

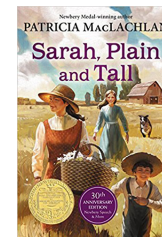
Lombard, Jenny

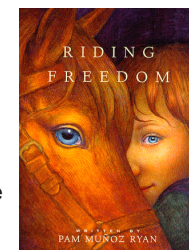
Pflugfelder, Bob

Charlotte Parkhurst runs away from an orphanage, moves to California, and fools everyone when she poses as a boy.



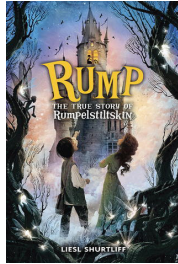


SPACEHEADZ

Fifth-grader Michael K. gradually comes to believe that two of his classmates are aliens who need his help.

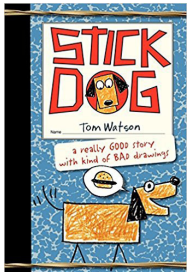
RUMP: THE TRUE STORY OF RUMPELSTILTSKIN

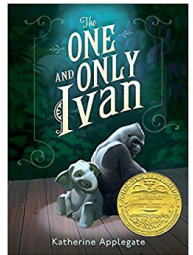
