
THE LAND OF ELVON BOOK I THE DARK HILLS

Just before her mother is to remarry, 12-year-old Zibby realizes that her antique dollhouse is haunted by ghosts, one of whom is out for revenge.




#### HOTHEAD Ripken, Cal

kill him for his connection to a hidden treasure.


#### **ESPERANZA RISING**
