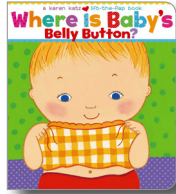


WHO ARE THEY?

PLANES GO

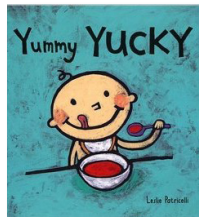
Light, Steve

PANCAKES!: COOK IN A BOOK

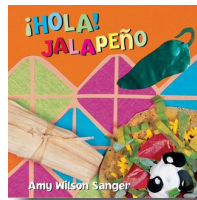
Nieminen, Lotta

REST

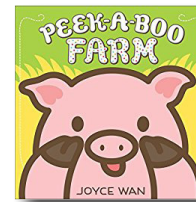
Verdick, Elizabeth

Colorful and fun peek-a-boo book! Can you guess which animal is hiding behind its hooves?

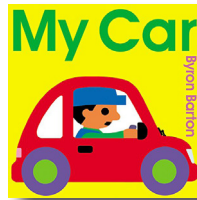


WHERE IS MY BABY?

CAN YOU GROWL LIKE A BEAR?

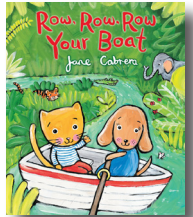
Butler, John

I SPY PETS

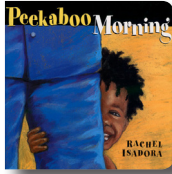
Gibbs, Edward

Isadora, Rachel

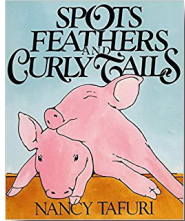
Baby plays a game of peekaboo with Mommy, Daddy, and even the family pet!

Van Laan, Nancy

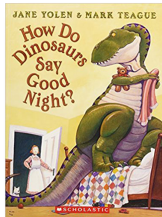
This book features food time fun with a toddler and mommy.

BESOS FOR BABY: A LITTLE BOOK OF KISSES

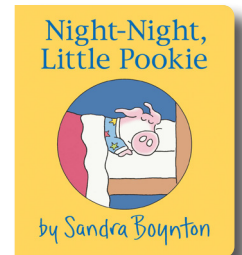
Arena, Jen
