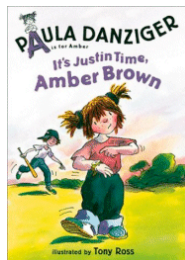


IT'S JUSTIN TIME, AMBER BROWN

BUNNICULA AND FRIENDS: HOT FUDGE

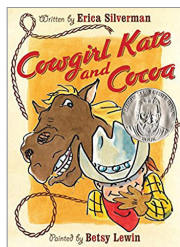
Howe, James

LING AND TING: TOGETHER IN ALL WEATHER

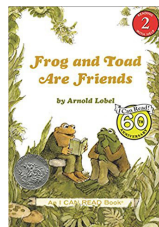
Lin, Grace

MR. PUTTER & TABBY TURN THE PAGE

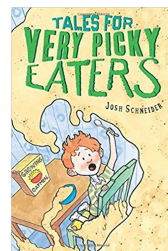

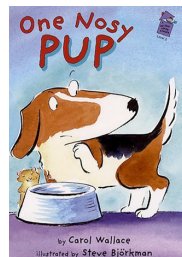
A father tells outlandish stories while trying to get his young son, who is a very picky eater, to eat foods he thinks he will not like.

ONE NOSY PUP

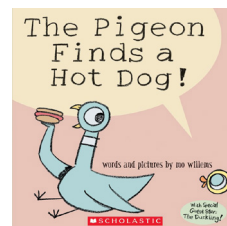
Wallace, Carol

Pigeon learns about sharing when a curious duckling keeps asking questions about the hot dog Pigeon has found.

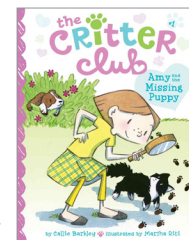

O'Connor, Jane

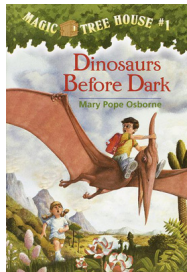
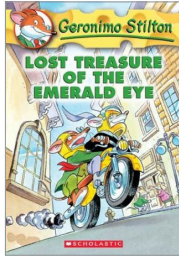

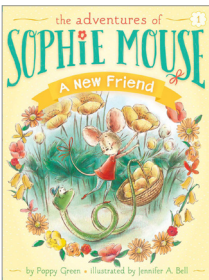
Eight-year-old Jack and his younger sister Annie find a magic treehouse, which whisks them back to an

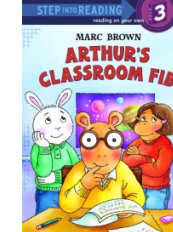
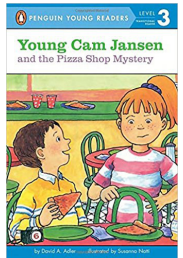
Adler, David A.
