What programs do the Centers offer? What ages do they serve?

- The Skokie center offers full- and part-day morning and afternoon programs for children aged 3 to 5 years.

What are the hours?

- Full-day programs: Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. during the fall and spring semesters (closed on Fridays during summer).
Full-day options include two to five days a week in the fall and spring semesters (two to four days during summer).
- Part-day programs (Skokie center only): two- or three-day morning classes or three-day afternoon classes during the fall and spring semesters. Summer sessions also available. For specific days and times, contact the Skokie site coordinator.

Who teaches my child?

- Experienced teachers work in teams and supervise students pursuing certificates or degrees in early education.
- The “lab” aspect of the program creates a dynamic, stimulating environment that supports learning.

Can I be involved in my child's classes?

Yes! Family involvement is at the core of our programs—and is essential to center quality and success.

- Parents are welcome in the centers at any time.
- Family Involvement Committees offer opportunities to participate in school-related activities.

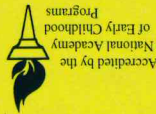
