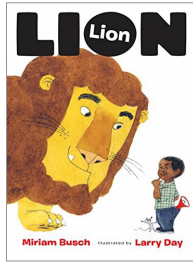


LION, LION Busch, Miriam

STACK THE CATS

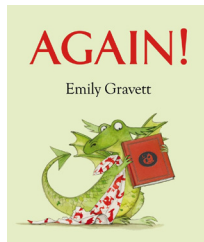
Ghahremani, Susie

AGAIN!

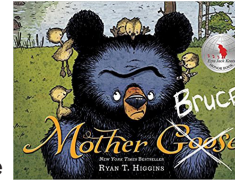
Gravett, Emily

MOTHER BRUCE Higgins, Ryan

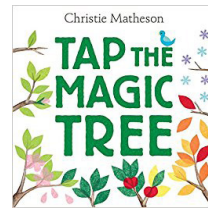
Bruce is a bear who likes his solitude. His peace and quiet ends when he inherits a gaggle of goslings; will he ever get rid of them?

BEE-BIM BOP!

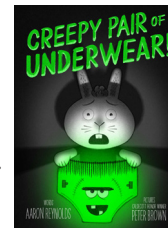
Park, Linda Sue

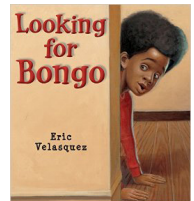
Tullet, Hervé

CITY SHAPES

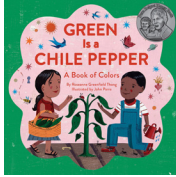
Murray, Diana

Barnett, Mac

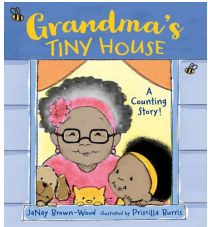
In this story, the author has promised us some monkeys, but they are not anywhere. Can you chase away the different animals and people, so the monkeys will come out?

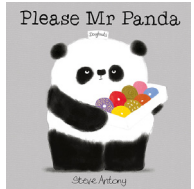
GOOD BOOKS FOR PRESCHOOL

Antony, Steve

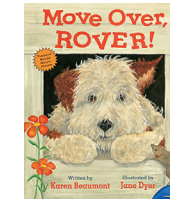
Silly manner story about animals who want to share Mr. Panda's donuts, but are not sure what polite word they need to use.
